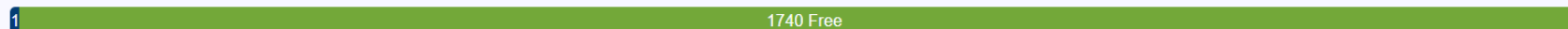

Request User Block

Request a block of user slots

Request a block of users for your pool
This process is not automatic. Your request will be sent to BSH. Once approved, your user pool will be increased.

Pricing

You will be invoiced monthly for the total number of users you have at the end of each month, charged at the Block rate for that number of users.

Example: Month one, you buy a block of 250 users at \$14.75 each, that's what you will be billed for at the end of the Month. Month two, you buy another block of 250 users = a total of 500 users, at the end of the Month you will be billed for 500 users at the 500 user block rate of \$11.60 per user, and so on.

Once 1000 users are reached, the charge out rate starts over as to the above for the total number of users per month.

Example: You have 2250 user slots in your pool. You will be billed at the lowest rate for 2000 users, and at the highest rate for the remaining 250 slots.

Slots	\$/slot/month
250	\$14.75
500	\$11.60
750	\$8.75
1000	\$7.50





Suspend Allocation Assign Yourself

SUSPEND AND RE-INSTATE CUSTOMER COMPANY ACCESS (Suspend a company account if they do not pay in time or at all. Once they bring their account up to date you can simply re-instate access to all their users).
